Procedury okuloplastyczne wykonywane u dzieci **Common Oculoplastic Conditions Affecting Children**

Care of the paediatric patient poses unique challenges for the Oculoplastic surgeon. Conditions of the ocular adnexa may threaten life and vision in children: preservation of life is the priority in orbital cellulitis and tumours; preservation of vision in cases where the eyelids do not function adequately to protect the cornea, such as colobomas and craniofacial syntosis, or where obstruction of vision might prove amblyogenic, as in the child with ptosis. In this lecture, we cover the common Oculoplastic presentations affecting children and discuss their management.
